Camp: Camp is on private property. CAMP OPENS THURSDAY. May set up crew area. Please do not attach or hang ANYTHING on fences. Water spigots/Easy access. <u>Leave no strings/water bottles/paper; fill any holes</u>. No personal fires.

Dogs on leash, but not allowed at registration, in vet check, food or crew area. Generators off at 10pm.

Directions: From N, on I-75, At Gainesville, exit # 384, Hwy. 24 west (Archer Rd.) to Bronson, turn L at light on US 27A, go 0.4 miles and turn R on CR 337; go past Black Prong TH to CR 326, turn L .go to SE 114th Ave (Steeple Chase sign) go L. Follow signs.

<u>From S</u>, on I-75, go thru Ocala to Williston exit #354 onto US 27A. Turn L. Turn L onto CR 326 at Blitchton (gas/goodies/ice/feed). Continue W on CR 326 to Morriston. Zigzag across US 41 (R then L). Stay on CR 326, cross SR 121...go R onto SE 114th Ave (Steeple Chase sign)

<u>From W</u>, off I-10, exit #225 S onto US 19 to Chiefland (gas/Super Wal-Mart/ice). Stay in L lane, turn L onto US 27A, go 11 miles to Bronson; 0.4 miles past light (at intersection 24) turn R onto CR 337, go past the Equestrian Center and the Black Prong TH sign to CR 326, go L. Follow signs.

<u>From E</u>, go W on SR 40 to CR 326, turn R and bypass Ocala. Cross over 441 & under I-75. Stay on CR 326, cross over US 27. Follow same as from the S.

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.

Should a hearing be requested, I agree to accept AS FINAL the decision of the particular hearing body. I agree to release, hold harmless and not to sue AHA, the Competition Sponsor, their officers, directors, employees, volunteers or members concerning any decision of AHA, the Competition, its Ride Management Committee, Ride Officials or any hearing body that relates to my qualifications or my horse(s)' qualifications to enter the Competition or any results of the Competition.
